The NBA Cares All-Star Day of Service will take place indoor this year, rain, snow or shine.

Will there be food and water allowed on site?

Yes, the NBA will provide volunteers with snacks and beverages throughout the afternoon.

Will there be bathrooms available?

Yes, there will be proper facilities on site.

Will there be a place to lock up my belongings?

No. All volunteers will be responsible for their own items, so please secure your valuables in your hotel room prior to attending the NBA Cares All-Star Day of Service.

Can I register my family for the NBA Cares All-Star Day of Service?

Yes! If you and your family have been invited to NBA All-Star, you are all invited to participate in the NBA Cares All-Star Day of Service. The site accommodates volunteers of all skill levels, ages 6 and up.

Can my friends and I be assigned to the same project?

All volunteer projects will take place at one site this year. Please note, volunteer slots are limited and will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
